Re: City Funding for Community Based Organizations for Census Engagement

Dear Deputy Mayor Thompson and Ms. Fonseca-Sabune:

As the 2020 census approaches, we are pleased that Mayor de Blasio is moving forward with a multi-faceted census outreach effort and look forward to working with you and the city's Census Office. We strongly urge that this outreach effort include significant funding for non-profit organizations.

While \$4.3 million in city funding for city outreach and publicity is commendable, we also want to note that just funding communications efforts and the City's own Census hires will be insufficient. We strongly urge that the city include adequate funding for non-profit organizations who will be on the front line of census outreach efforts at the neighborhood level. These integral partners will be at the forefront of census outreach efforts in the city's "hard to count" communities.

The first online census and the proposed citizenship question further highlight the need to support efforts at the local effort to help count families with limited or no internet service and who are fearful of government intrusion into their lives.

We would like to work with you to propose realistic funding goals for community outreach efforts and models for how such funding could work.
